## Indiana Theological Seminary to McCormick Theological Seminary \*

Located in the frontier town of Hanover, Indiana, the Indiana Theological Seminary in 1826 had its humble beginnings. They relocated in New Albany Indiana, and changed the name to New Albany Theological Seminary. In a religiously conservative schism a branch split, moved to Chicago encouraged by a donation from Cyrus McCormick in 1859, and renamed themselves as the Presbyterian Theological Seminary of the Northwest.
